

# **COVID-19 COLOR CODE ACTION POLICY<sup>1</sup>**

### **GREEN:**

The risk of COVID-19 exposure at Lemberg CC, on campus and in Waltham is determined to be low by public health authorities. The decision to wear a mask inside or to test is a personal choice. There is no requirement to wear a mask, or test for COVID-19 to be inside our facility.

# YELLOW:

Masks are required in any indoor gathering of 20 or more individuals. Otherwise, wearing a mask inside is optional.

A negative test result from an At-home Rapid Antigen Test is required when returning to Lemberg CC from a break exceeding 4 days, or when an individual has been in a higher risk situation.

# **ORANGE:**

Masks are required in any indoor gathering of 8 or more individuals. The Center may provide Rapid Antigen Testing and require COVID testing prior to arrival at the Center. Testing frequency will be determined by the exposures at the Center, the number of individuals with COVID-like symptoms at the Center, and the frequency of cases at the Center.

### RED:

Masks inside are required. Adults and children should keep 6 feet apart while eating or drinking indoors. Lemberg may require frequent Rapid Antigen Testing in classrooms prior to arrival at the Center.

Note - masks are never required for children under age 3
